ARTICLE I - Organization

Section 1 - Groups

CHANGE: The Appalachian Search & Rescue Conference, Inc. (ASRC) shall be divided into field organizations called "Groups". Each Group shall provide for itself whatever name, organization, operating procedures, and training it deems appropriate, providing it adheres to the articles of Incorporation, Bylaws, operational procedures specified in the ASRC Operations Manual, and training requirements and standards specified in the ASRC Training Guide.

The Appalachian Search & Rescue Conference, Inc. (ASRC) shall be divided into field organizations called "Certified Groups" and "Affiliate Groups".  - a. The sponsoring Certified Group approves the application of the Affiliate Group and vouches for its interest and capabilities.
 - b. The Affiliate Group completes a probationary period of a minimum of six months.
 - c. The Affiliate Group obtains, for full Certification, a vote of two-thirds of the members with Conference voting rights voting on the question in a membership meeting.
