ASRC General Meeting Minutes 09 April 2005

Minutes:

1. Welcome by the Chair

- 1.1. A minute of silence was held in honor of Peter McCabe (MSAR), former ASRC Chair, Vice Chair, Ops Officer, and longtime conference member.
- 1.2. An invitation was extended to join the local Astronomy Club from 8 to 11 up at the park's main buildings following the meeting
- 1.3. NASAR cards were distributed.
- 1.4. The Chair began his term trying to get the conference to review itself, some of which has happened. Now he intends to put it together into a whole. The intention is to define our Operational Doctrine and build upon it, have our Training measured by ability, and make the Conference something members are proud to be a part of and want to better.
- 1.5. A warm welcome was extended to representatives from DELMARVA and TROT-SAR, two groups approved to join the Conference as Probationary members during the Board meeting.

2. Anniversary Pins.

2.1. The Vice Chair distributed awards for members who had attained multiples of five years of service with the Conference. Highlights included 20 years for Dave Carter (TSAR) and Art Dodds (MARG), as well as Don Scelza (AMRG) barking for Five year awards for two AMRG dogs.

3. Elections:

- 3.1. There were not enough Conference members and proxies present for quorum. The following appointments were announced:
 - 3.1.1. Treasurer to be passed from Amanda Harrison (BRMRG) to Kevin Maskell (BRMRG) later in April.
 - 3.1.2. Secretary was consolidated under Kevin Cropper (MSAR), who was previously Recording Secretary only.
 - 3.1.3. CTO had already transitioned to Mark Creighton (SMRG) after work took Billy Morgan (TSAR) away.
 - 3.1.4. Ops is now led by Bob Allam (PSAR) after the passing of Peter McCabe (MSAR).

4. Treasurer's Report:

- 4.1. The Treasurer reported the balance as of 06 April 2005 was \$6323.84, up \$89.37 from the balance reported 20 January 2005.
- 4.2. Due to the insurance bill, the Conference needs more money. Dues were already increased, but more is necessary.
- 4.3. A suggestion was made to ask the states to help fund operational costs (e.g., insurance); perhaps the Department of Homeland Security could help.

- 6.3. Documentation is expected within the quarter for Operational Doctrine, which will then be used to develop the Operations Manual within the half year.
