1. The meeting was called to order at 0930.

  - 3.2.1. Motion Passed
- 3.3. Chair Brought forward concerns about current process of Background checks. Concerned about only using VSP as resource of Checks. Chair proposes to put committee together to investigate other opportunities of background checks and possible new or redefined policy. (Committee- Jim Jackson, Lovell Mayle, Robert Peterson, Chair- Steve Weiss) Current concerns are the lack of positive response and VA only check

  - 4.2.1. Organization currently solvent, all groups paid except PVRG
    - 4.2.1.1.Problem with clarity of rosters
    - 4.2.1.2. Reminder that rosters are supposed to be submitted within a month of any change
- 4.3. Insurance questions
  - 4.3.1. There was a request for significant waiver for the FSE that SMRG did recently
  - 4.3.2. Current liability is \$500,000 while standard seems to be \$1 million

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- 4.3.3. There is a need to up liability and re-evaluate the medical insurance piece (Questions of note: does it cover medical malpractice? Equipment insurance?) Secretary will follow up. Alex McLellan did some research on this topic, could be available to give more information.
- 4.4. VA 067-06 Powattan resolved with TSAR reminding and/or providing extra training to its members. One member resigned over this incident and has since requested task forms. Chair's response is that mission records are held in confidence. He worked with Mark Eggeman and sent copies of correspondence to VDEM, so state will be involved with any further issues regarding this individual.
  - 4.4.1. Ouestions that arose due to this incident:
    - 4.4.1.1.Is there a way for groups to remove members by way of the ASRC? Groups can go through ASRC bylaws to remove members if necessary, though it is preferable to do so on the group level. Reminder to groups to have procedures in place for such an event.
    - 4.4.1.2. What are SOPs for responding with other resources? ASRC clearly won't be using dogs in VA anytime soon. Still unresolved, though, are deployment issues for deploying non-state resources. State MOU is being rewritten soon. Will need to be signed before the next board meeting. The Chair will be soliciting input on private BOD list before MOU is complete.
