Event Details

Exercise activities will begin Friday evening, April 9th, with limited night operations and a focus on planning for Saturday operations. The SAR Incident Commander for that shift of the exercise will determine the necessary scope of operations. Please contact sim@smrg.org if you wish to be included for consideration. After a change of base personnel at approximately 0700 on Saturday the 10th, full daytime field operations will commence. Base staff will plan to deploy all SAR resources from roughly 0700 until the scenario wraps up later that day.
