Repeater Capability on KA 8 1942: FCC has taken the position that although the license Coordinator made an error; the license must be recoordinated to add repeater capability. This will cost several thousand.

S.N.P. agreements: Renewal of KB 6 1630 is being done by John Kihl. The letter from the acting Park Super. has been received. Note, this "permanent" agreement is unusual. The park also has a written agreement to use our frequencies.
