Members: if you receive the page "100 647-7828", call STATCOM at 647-7828.

First member to reach STATCOM:

- Get the alerting information and thank the STAT Dispatcher.
- Then, call 640-1000. Enter the following: 101#.
- Contact whoever called STATCOM for help and get the appropriate information.
- If it is NOT the ASRC Dispatch Officer, immediately alert an ASRC Conference Alert Officer (AO) by calling 1-804-674-2400 and giving the Virginia Emergency Operations Center Duty Officer your name and phone number, and ask for an ASRC Conference AO to call you.
- Next, either become Group Dispatcher yourself or use the pager or call down the roster to find a Group Dispatcher.
- Call 640-1000. Enter the following: 552**YYY*YYY# where YYY-YYYY is your phone number.

Members with pagers:

if you receive a 552 page right after a 101 page, and you can serve as Group Dispatcher for the operation, please call the number on the pager.

Paging Instructions, once Group Dispatcher established:

Call 640-1000. Enter following: XXX**105**YYY*YYY# where "XXX" is the appropriate code (111 for Notification, 222 for Alert, 333 for Full Callout, etc.) and YYY-YYYY is the Group Dispatcher's telephone number.

Note that the terms are Dispatch Officer (DO) for the Conference dispatch person in Charlottesville, and Dispatcher (DS) for the person who is filling the dispatch function for AMRG here in the Pittsburgh area. • To reset message: 0, then 8343 (but not needed when I tried), then 11 to access outgoing message, then 30 to re-record, then 1 to save, and then 40 to play back; 30 starts recording again. A=Group; B=private
