
Instructions:


Go to the parking lot for the Western Pennsylvania Conservancy's *Bear Run Nature Reserve*. The Nature Reserve is across the road from the famous Frank Lloyd Wright landmark house, Fallingwater. It is about 2 miles north of Ohiopyle on PA Route 381.

Navigate, in order, to the eight points on the enlarged, gridded map. Find the 8.5"x11" marker with an orange half-square at each station. Each marker is attached to a tree near waist level. At each point, write down the letter marked on the marker in the blank below. Each marker has a latter from A to H. You have completed the course when you have found all markers. For an additional challenge, try doing the course backwards.
