REQUIRED TRAINING

The ASRC Training Guide (First Edition, September 1977) stipulates that, in order for a certified member to remain certified, he or she must face an annual review of skills and knowledge by the Group Training Officer; the last date for such review in our group will be Dec. 31, 1977 for certification renewal for the calendar year 1978. Talk to the Training Officer if you have any questions about it.

The Training Guide also stipulates that, in order to remain a certified member, one must attend a minimum of 32 hours of field training each year, including 8 hours of search and 8 hours of mountain rescue. The BRMRG Board of Directors is specifying that EVERY member who is a trainee or certified member must attend at least one search session and one semi-technical evacuation session in order to maintain active membership status in the group. Members who fail to do so will have their membership status changed to Associate or Auxiliary. Both search sessions have passed, but there are still two semi-tech evac sessions left. If you have a problem making the required sessions, talk to the Training Officer.

EXPIRATION OF TRAINEE STATUS

A Trainee membership is good for a period of one year (except in very unusual cases). At the end of that year, the Trainee must either become a Basic member, or be dropped to Associate, Auxiliary, or non-member status. Many Trainee memberships will be expiring in the next few months. Check with the Training Officer if you are not sure of your status.
