# Search and Rescue Training Announcment

The Shenandoah Mountain Rescue Group will be sponsoring training classes for Field Team Member (FTM) and Field Team Leader (FTL) on the dates below. The training curriculum and related field activities will at a minimum meet ASRC training standards for FTM and FTL, which will meet the Virginia SAR Program standards for FTM and FTL.

We welcome any member of an active SAR organization. However, the schedule and activities were intended to be logistically feasible for individuals in the Washington metro area. We must limit the number of participants to 20 for each course. FTM is an entry-level course. FTL is an advanced course requiring previous FTM certification. Students must have current life and health insurance.

Cost to students is expected to be: FTM \$35, and FTL \$50 to cover all student materials, food, and production expenses. Students must pass both a written and practical test for successful completion of the course. Actual training level certification is conferred by the group training officer for ASRC members.

CAUTION #2: The SMRG training officer and the class instructor reserve the right to deny participation to a student on the grounds that serious physical harm may result from the more rigorous field training activities. Some of the activities required are: hiking straight up steep, mountainous ravines, rappelling off cliffs, carrying 40 lbs for a hundred yards, and nighttime driving. Students are advised to be in good health and, if prudent, obtain a physical exam by a medical doctor prior to enrolling in the course.
